Public schools throughout California are required to provide information about themselves to the community in the form of an annual School Accountability Report Card (SARC). These report cards provide a variety of data to allow the public to evaluate and compare schools in several important areas:

- demographic information
- school safety and climate for learning
- academic data
- class size
- teacher and staff information
- professional development
- fiscal and expenditure data

The SARC, which follows the state's guidelines and document template, are issued each spring and focus on the *previous* academic year. A SARC is typically 12- 14 pages long.
